

WHAT IS CASE MANAGEMENT ACCELERATED TRAINING (CMAT)?

CMAT is a paid 11-week professional development opportunity for qualified participants to gain the skill set needed to be successful applicants for case management jobs in Massachusetts. This program is funded through an EOHHS workforce development grant.



WHO IS A QUALIFIED PARTICIPANT?

Individuals who do not have a 4-year degree and have related experience in the human services field. This includes high school graduates, those with GEDs, and individuals with up to and including 2-year associate degrees with experience related to human services or providing care to others.
